SHOWS HOW THE MEMBERS OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT (MEPS) FROM THE POLITICAL GROUP VOTED ON KEY LGBTIQ+ TEXTS OVER THE LAST 5 YEARS. A HIGH VOTING INDICATOR DEMONSTRATES A STRONG SUPPORT. THE INDICATORS VARIES FROM -5.6 FOR ID TO 7.9 FOR THE GREENS. GROUP RANKING 6/7

COMPARES THE POLITICAL GROUP WITH THE OTHER 6 POLITICAL GROUPS IN THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT BASED ON THE VOTING INDICATOR
